Entry Fee: \$20 – Stock, Modified, Long Jump

Premiums: Stock \$300 - \$275 - \$220 - \$210 - \$190 - \$165 - \$140 - \$115

9th thru 14th placing receive \$100 15th thru 21st placing receive \$50

Modified \$350 - \$300 - \$250 - \$210 - \$190 - \$165 - \$140 - \$115

9th thru 13th placing receive \$100 14th thru 21st placing receive \$75

Mortified long jump \$250 to the longest jump \$10 entry fee (have to be entered in Modified Class)

Stock Long Jump \$200 to the longest jump \$10 entry fee (have to be entered in Stock Class)

Rough Truck Contest Rules

Entry Rules

1. Driver must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
2. Driver must sign a form, releasing Summit County Fair, Summit County Fair Board and its people from Liability. Those under 18 must have a parents/guardian consent form signed and witnessed.
3. Driver must show proof of ownership for licensed stock vehicles at the time of entry. (Title or Sales Receipt)
4. No entries can be made once a class begins.
5. No double entry of vehicles by same driver, car can be entered by more than one driver
- 6. Entry fee \$25 includes 1 pit pass admission for driver.**
*****Race Itself*****
 1. Driver must wear DOT or Snell Approved, full face helmet and EYE protection. Seat belt must be secure and fastened during competition.
 - A. Stock Class**, Vehicle does not have to be street legal, engine and suspension can NOT be modified with the exception of open exhaust. No tubular frames, or open wheeled vehicles. Each cone hit is a 5 second penalty time added to final time. (can be trailed in)
B. Modified Class, Anything above and beyond street legal. Each cone hit is a 5 second penalty time added to final time
 3. Any vehicle may be entered in the competition. (Stock Class ONLY)
 4. Unsafe operation in pit area could result in disqualification. Leaving the marked course area will result in disqualification. More than 5 cones knocked over will disqualify time & jump.
 5. Vehicles will be inspected for structural integrity prior to competition.
 6. All vehicles must have roof or roll cage and driver side netting.
 7. No cut, ground bar, or special tires allowed. No stud tires.
 8. Fuel cell or original fuel tank must be securely fastened.
 9. No pressurized fuels allowed. No NITROUS OXIDE
 10. All vehicles must have working breaks at inspection and at the start line.
 - 11. All Pickup trucks must have clean beds and all bodies must be secure to the frames.**
 12. There will be a mandatory driver's meeting before the event starts
 - 13. Inspectors and judges decisions are final.**
 14. This will be a times event. Each cone hit is a 5 second penalty time added to final time.
 15. All air bags must be disconnected.
 16. A five point racing harness can be used only if using a roll cage mounted to the frame.
 17. All drivers need to wear protective clothing – long sleeve shirts, shoes, no shorts.
 18. No extra weight of any kind may be added.
 - 19. Additional safety regulations and/or rules may be imposed at race time.**
 20. Any deliberate infraction of the rules will result in vehicle being scratched and the driver will be banned for a minimum of one year.
 21. If a red flag is waved by a judge anytime during the race the driver must stop right away.
 22. Anyone disqualified will not receive any prize money.
 23. No obscenities will be on any vehicle.
 24. Battery needs to be fasted down and covered.
- 25. No drinking of alcoholic beverages on the track and/or infield. The Summit County Fair reserves the right to search any vehicle entering the infield. Anyone that appears to be impaired by the rough truck committee may be disqualified and removed from the grounds. Management reserves the right to Re-teck a vehicle for any reason and reserves the right to disqualify or deny any driver the right to compete if management feels either vehicle or driver is unsafe for any reason.**

Enter off of 91 North of Howe Road, Parking entrance, stay Right up the road, pit on the right the wood line.
