

Livestock Committee JFB Meeting 10/4/2020

I. Called to order at 4:03 P.M.

II. Minutes were accepted.

III. Premium Book Changes

- Poultry

- A. Regulation #3 – All chickens shown must be pullorum tested. They must be banded exclusively with metal, permanent, numbered leg bands. Band numbers must be listed on the test paper. Tests must be conducted not more than 90 days prior to the opening of the fair. Testing will be available Monday for 4-hers, \$1.00 per bird. Waterfowl are excluded from pullorum testing. Turkeys must be tested by a veterinarian or show NPIP paperwork.
 - B. Regulation 4 – Turkeys Only! Turkeys must be tested by a licensed veterinarian 90 days prior to the fair. Serum to be sent to Reynoldsburg lab. Leg band numbers to be listed on all paperwork. Exception: You have NPIP paperwork from the hatchery where the turkeys were purchased, and you never housed them on property with untested poultry.
 - C. Regulation 9 – Change ‘April 1’ to ‘between 16-20 weeks prior to fair’.
 - D. Regulation 14 – Change date to Feb. 3
 - E. Regulation 16 – Change to MONDAY
 - F. Regulation 19 – Change to ‘Barn duty during fair will be scheduled by the barn superintendent’
 - G. ADD: Costume Class
 - H. ADD: Cloverbud Fun Class
 - I. REMOVE: Market Geese Class
 - J. Add Regulations:
This is a terminal Sale. The poultry committee will arrange transport for all market birds to a licensed, inspected Poultry processor. After processing, each 4-Her will be required to pick up their processed meat at the fairgrounds and deliver to their buyer, having made arrangements for delivery ahead of time.
 - K. SHOW DATE CHANGED TO WEDNESDAY 9:00am.
- Rabbits
- A. No exceptions 3: Book judging July 17. Market Rabbit Books need to be completed to date on July 17, and the complete book is due Sunday by 1:00 P.M.
 - B. Rule 8: Add talk to coordinator.

- Large Livestock

A. Beef/Hogs

- Regulation 11- Add: 4-Hers w/ market projects must turn in their up to date project books at weigh/check in. Project books will be returned on Auction Night. Completed Books and buyer thank you notes must be turned in Sunday of Fair to the Barn Coordinator between 5-6 P.M. Remove: August 10.
- Regulation 14- Change Thursday to Friday.

B. Lambs

- Regulation 12- Add: 4-Hers w/ market projects must turn in their up to date project books at weigh/check in. Project books will be returned on Auction Night. Completed Books and buyer thank you notes must be turned in Sunday of Fair to the Barn Coordinator between 5-6 P.M. Remove: August 10.
- Regulation 14- Change Wednesday/Thursday to Friday.

C. Goats

- Regulation 13- Add: 4-Hers w/ market projects must turn in their up to date project books at weigh/check in. Project books will be returned on Auction Night. Completed Books and buyer thank you notes must be turned in Sunday of Fair to the Barn Coordinator between 5-6 P.M. Remove: August 10.
- Regulation 16- Change Wednesday/Thursday to Friday.

- General Rules

- A. Need to add read species.
- B. Regulation 4- Add Summit County 4-Her.
- C. Regulation 9- Add non-market goat possession date. (June 1st).
- D. Regulation 10- Add in weight and/or breed classes.
- E. Regulation 12- Add all animals (remove market)
- F. Regulation 13- Add Fancy.
- G. All market projects must complete showmanship.

IV. General Livestock

A. Auction time 5/7

1. Small market animals displayed in cages and sold by numbers. Large market animals will be brought into the show ring.
2. Want list of buyers and prices spreadsheet.
3. Processor needs to go through the JFB , not 4-H club.
4. Make signs for buyers (auction account)
5. Make the option of donating or keeping the meat clearer to buyers.

B. Processors have to be licensed for species.

C. QA date will be online and in-person. Date TBA.

- D. Put specific book turn in dates in premium books.
- E. Subcommittees will form a list of judges. Give judges to JR. Fair Secretary and she will hire them. JF Coordinator notified to make show arrangements. No 4-H advisor should be hiring judges.
- F. All market projects must complete showmanship.
- G. Give 4-Her a copy of the premium book and have 4-Her and parent sign form. The form is to be turned into the advisor, and the advisor should turn into JR. Fair Coordinator either by possession date or March 15th, whichever is first. Poultry turns in at the same time as bird order.

V. Large Livestock

- A. Buyers' Dinner- Grab & Go style.
- B. Show days. Wednesday: Pigs 6:30 P.M. Thursday : Steers, Lambs, Goats 6:30 P.M.
- E. Paylean forms are signed every year.
- G. Wash Rack sign up chart. Go to people with other shows first. Poultry and rabbit kids get first pick.

VI. Poultry

- A. Show day. Wednesday morning.
- B. All poultry goes to the same licensed processor. (Buckeye)
- C. Parents can't clean, feed or water birds without 4-Her present. Add to the premium book.
- D. Uniform bird pickup. Refrigerator box truck donated.

VII. Rabbit

- A. Move showmanship before the show.
- B. Requiring ad-book or sponsorship sales of \$20 for anyone doing a rabbit/cavy project, not just market. Add to the premium book.

VIII. Goats

- A. Show day Tuesday and have printed show form.
- B. The Goat subcommittee was not represented; therefore, we tabled making any changes other than the show date.

IX. Showman of Showman

- A. Possible academic challenge.

- A. Receipts go to JR. Fair Secretary.
- B. Poultry: Approved budget of \$2,705.95
