for the 2023 Fair**

FEEDER CALF RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All beef feeders must be in the possession of the exhibitor by **June 1, 2023** and positively identified with the Summit County Ear Tag
2. A beef feeder calf may be a steer or heifer
- 3. Steer much be castrated by fair and free of testicular tissue. All calves must be dehorned.**
4. Exhibitors may show up to two feeder calves and tag in a third.
5. Beef Feeders must be born between December 1, 2022 and March 1, 2023.
6. Beef Feeders must weigh no less than 300 pounds and must not exceed 650 pounds. Weigh in will be **Monday before fair from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm.**
7. Beef Feeders will be shown by weight.
8. Beef Feeders must be pure or a cross of beef breeds.
9. No bottle calves.
10. Calves will not sell through the Summit County Livestock Auction.
11. Exhibitors must turn in **\$75.00** worth of Jr. Fair Sponsorships.
12. A home visit/health check will be made prior to the fair. Must have proof of at least one round of vaccines.
