

2020 CONCESSION VENDOR ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT COVID RULES

THESE RULES MAY REPLACE OR ADD TO OUR CONCESSION RULES

- 1) **REPLACING RULE 1 - HOURS** - You are required to have your booth open to the public Wednesday 11:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. WEDNESDY 11AM TO 1PM WILL BE HIGH RISK HOURS, Thursday - Saturday 12:00 pm until 11:00 pm, and on Sunday from 12:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Virginia OCasek & Strip building do close one hour before the fair closes each night. IT IS REQUIRED TO HAVE YOUR BOOTH UP AND OPEN DURING ALL HOURS. WE HAVE A THREE STRIKE POLICY IF YOU OPEN LATE, CLOSE EARLY OR TEAR DOWN EARLY – EACH TIME YOU WILL BE GIVEN A WARNING ON THE THIRD WARNING YOU WILL NOT BE ASKED BACK FOR THE FOLLOWING YEAR. (Commercial Booths do not need to be manned as long as they are up and open)
- 2) **REPLACING RULE 2 – SET UP - Outside Booths and Strip Building Booths** can set up starting Friday before fair at 10:00 a.m. **Virginia OCasek Party Center Building** set up may begin the MONDAY AND TUESDAY 10AM TO 9PM **Booths must be completely set up by 10:00 a.m. on WEDESDAY**, the opening day of the fair.
- 3) **FOOD VENDORS** – AS OF JUNE 11, 2020 YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO MARK YOUR SERVING LINES ON THE GROUND WITH CHALK PAINT 6FT APART. If this rule changes we will let you know on setup
- 4) **REQUIREMENTS** – Depending on Health Department you staff manning the booth may have to wear masks – food and commercial have to as of June 11, 2020 follow the Ohio Responsible Restart Ohio Guidelines for food and retail. We will update you on how these change.
- 5) **CHANGES** - Due to COVID19 CHANGES may occur from now until the opening day of fair and rules may need to be added or removed due to the Health Department mandates.

BY SIGNATURE BELOW, YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE ABOVE RULES OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY/SUMMIT COUNTY FAIR there is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present.
