

# SUMMIT CO. JFB LIVESTOCK COMMITTEE MINUTES

## Sub-Committee Reports and New Business

- **Poultry** – Processing date may be moved back one day. They will let us know by June.
- **Goat** – Account is negative. They will possibly put on a show next year. Fundraisers this year are the Adbook sales, concessions from the Rabbit Fun Fair and basket raffle. Looking into having a Goat Chip Bingo (possibly at the Summit Flea in May). Goats are getting new cages this year.
- **Large Livestock** – The sub committee could not come to an agreement on the awards and banners. A proposal was brought to the Livestock Committee to not put sponsor names on the awards since everyone is donating the same amount of money. All award banners would be the same size.

Possibilities for auction banners: Buyers: 8x11 (12)\$180.00 Kids: 15x27 (12)\$408.00

Or: 24x42 (6)\$276.00 and 13x24 (6)\$174.00 totaling \$450.00 plus \$15.00 shipping.

May 1- Hog tag in. Someone expressed concern about hauling in the pigs to the fairgrounds and the exhibitor tagging their own pigs. We will call Jenny and see what she thinks.

Livestock committee will need to vote on these proposals since the sub-committee vote was tied.

- **Rabbit** – Fun Fair in June – subcommittees will be making raffle baskets. Proceeds go to each committee for their basket. We still need a processor for market rabbits. Imani said he would check around to see where other counties are taking them.
- **Photo Booths** - Barn Coordinators should create a photo booth or photo area for the 4-H youth to take pictures with their projects. Club names should NOT be put on them as these photo areas will be used for all kids from any club in the barn.

**NOTE:** Since we did not have enough Livestock Committee members present, we did not have a quorum for voting. Any changes or proposals will need to be discussed and voted on by the Livestock committee.

**UPDATE ON May 1 HOG TAG-IN** – After the livestock meeting, more discussion was made. Jenny agreed to go around to the exhibitor farms (or an adult advisor or JFB adult volunteer) and tag the hogs. Imani gave the go ahead to make the change and extend the tag in date to May 8. Possession date is still May 1 and no one should acquire pigs for fair after May 1.
