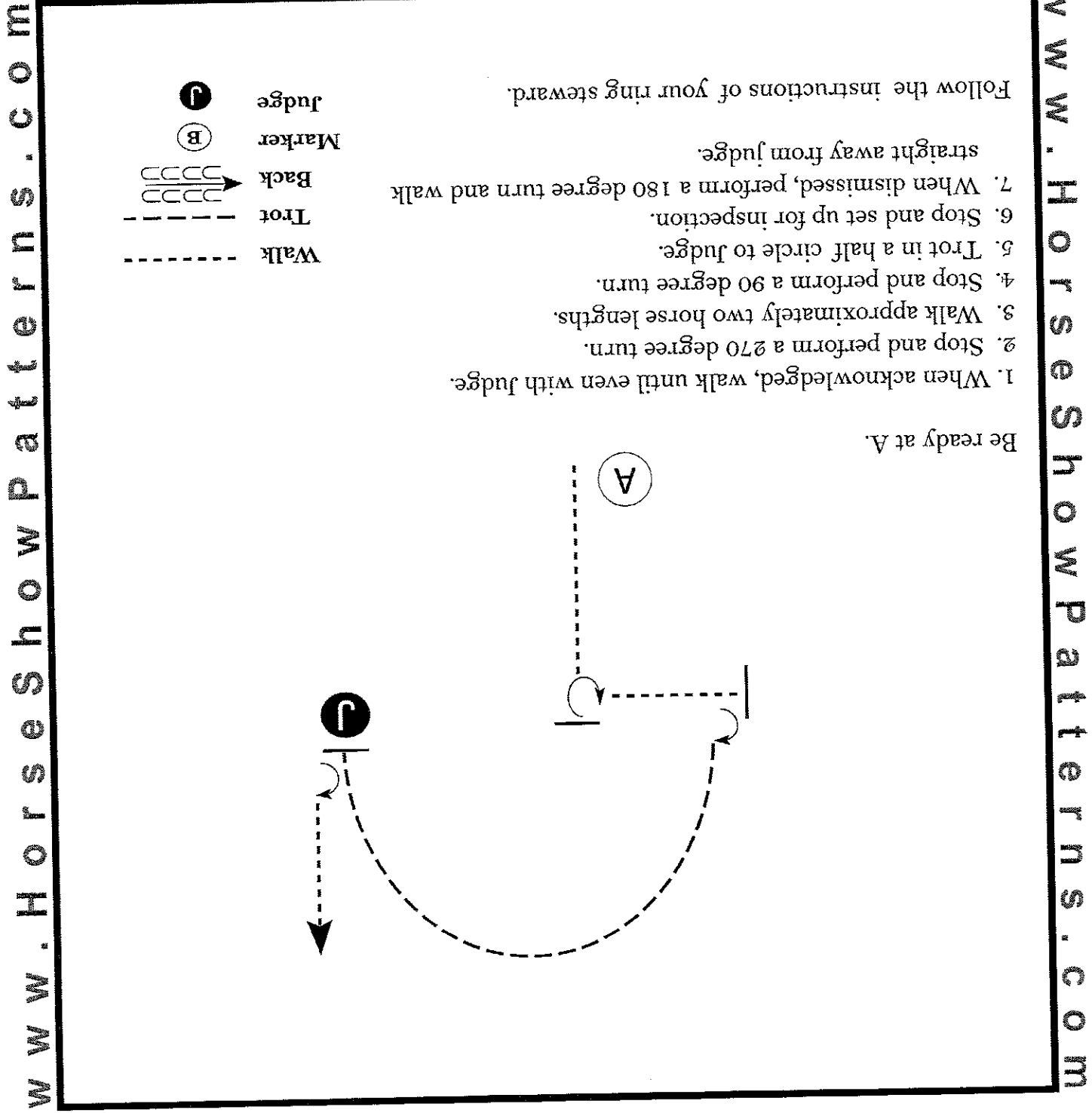

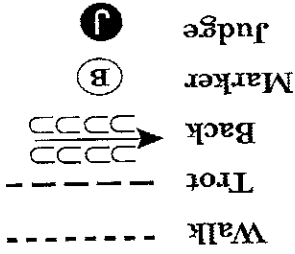

Be ready at A.

1. When acknowledged, walk until even with Judge.
2. Stop and perform a 270 degree turn.
3. Walk approximately two horse lengths.
4. Stop and perform a 90 degree turn.
5. Trot in a half circle to Judge.
6. Stop and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, perform a 180 degree turn and walk straight away from Judge.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.





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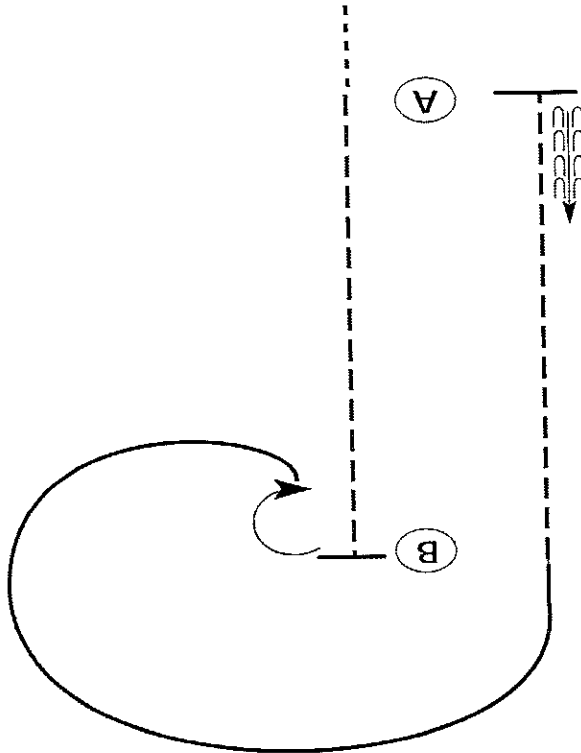

 6. Stop at A and back approximately one horse length.

 WDAA 2017 WESTERN DRESSAGE BASIC LEVEL TEST 1



PURPOSE	Tests confirm that the horse is supple and moves freely forward in a clear steady rhythm, accepting light contact with the bit. The horse demonstrates greater understanding of the aids and calm acceptance of the bridle, greater emphasis is placed on relaxation, harmony, fluidity and pure gait. The horse is beginning to develop more impulsion and balance.
NEW REQUIREMENTS	20m circle at the working lope 20m circle at the free jog
ENTRY NO.	
ARENA SIZE:	Small (40m x 20m) or Large (60m x 20m)
AVERAGE RIDE TIME:	3:30 (Small) or 4:30 (Large)
MAXIMUM PTS:	240

All jog work may be ridden sitting or rising.

Maneuvers for Ranch Riding Pattern A

1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extend the trot, stop.
4. 360 degree turn to the left.
5. Lope left lead for 1/2 circle, lope to the center.
6. Simple or flying change of lead.
7. Lope right lead for 1/2 circle.
8. Extend the lope up the long side of the arena.
9. Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to center.
10. Extended trot.
11. Walk over poles.
12. Stop and back.

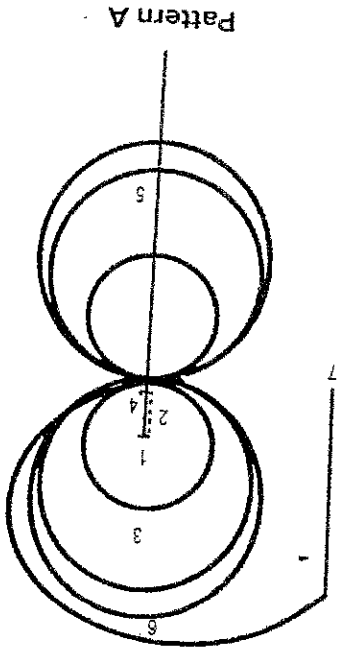

REINING PATTERNS

Ride Pattern A as follows:

- Maneuver 1
Lope in a straight line down the center of the arena past the second cone and stop.
- Maneuver 2
Back to the center of the pattern, pivot right.
- Maneuver 3
Lope a large fast circle to the left, then a slow small circle, then a large fast one.
- Maneuver 4
Do a flying lead change.
- Maneuver 5
Lope a large fast circle to the right followed by a small slow circle and then another large fast circle.
- Maneuver 6
Change leads and lope a large fast loop around the end of the circles made to the left, straighten your horse, and run down past the center marker.
- Maneuver 7
Stop; exit the arena.

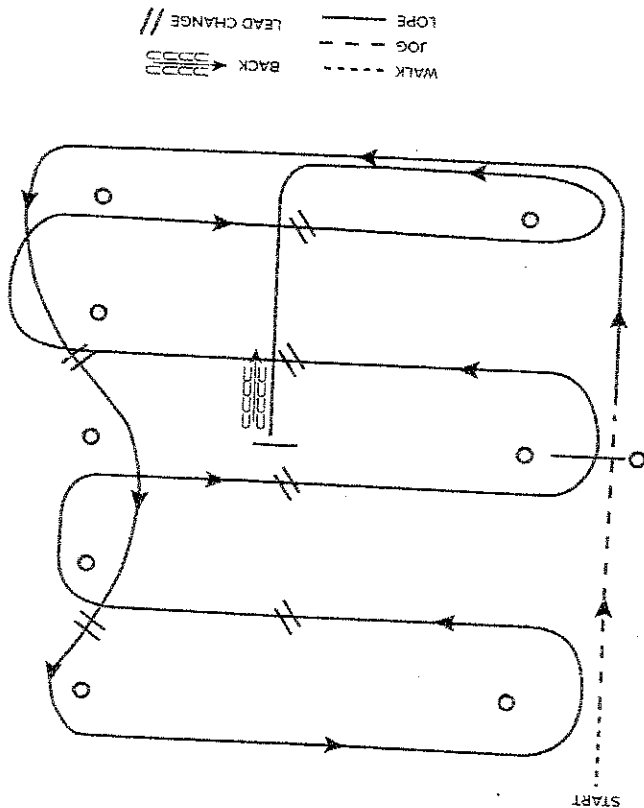

Maneuvers for Western Riding Pattern A

N2V

1. Walk to the first pylon and begin jogging to and over the log.
2. Transition to left lead lope and lope around the pylon.
3. First line change.
4. Second line change.
5. Lope around pylon.
6. Lope around pylon and first crossing change.
7. Second crossing change.
8. Lope over log.
9. Third crossing change.
10. Fourth crossing change.
11. Lope up the center, stop, and back.
