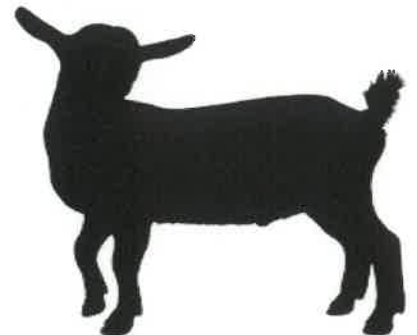
REGULATIONS:

1. Check in is Monday July 26th from 11:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. Goats must be in place by 8:00 p.m. Monday.
2. All Goats must show no visible signs of superficial abscesses, sore mouth, foot rot, pink eye, ring worm, lice, or any other contagious disease.
3. Divisions will be shown by breed if there are sufficient number of entries per breed. (Pygmy, Nigerian, Alpine, Nubians, LaMancha, Saanen, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grades)
4. Grain, hay, and bedding must be provided by the 4-H'er.
5. Angora and Pygmy goats should not be clipped. Angora goats should not get bathed prior to show.
6. No horned or un-castrated males.
7. Milk areas must be tidy and clean by 9:00am daily.
8. All goats 18 months or age or older must have a Flock ID number OR breeder tattoo in the RIGHT ear, and an individual identification tattoo number in the LEFT ear (microchips may be used in place of tattoos ONLY IF you provide a microchip reader at check-in). Registrations papers must accompany each goat over 18 months of age. Goat tattoo or Microchip AND owner name must match the registration papers. If your goat is unregistered, you will need to provide a Certificate of Identification with Flock Origin and Breeder's information. Bring a copy of all paperwork to check-in to give to the species coordinator.
9. Release date is Sunday August 1st at 8:00 P.M.
10. All general livestock rules apply. See General Livestock page in Premium book or PDF page on fair website
11. Goats must be in possession by June 1.
12. All goat projects must compete in Showmanship
13. Suggested Dairy Uniform - White shirt, white pants.
14. Exhibitors responsibility to clean and maintain stalls. Please clean up after your animal.
15. 4-H'er's should see Jr. Fair Coordinator at check in for barn duties and responsibilities assignment. Barn Duty scheduling will be determine by the barn coordinator.
16. Each exhibitor is required to turn in \$30 worth of Ad Book sales or Sponsorships.

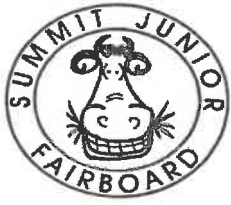
