## RULES & REGULATIONS TO QUALIFY TO GO TO STATE FAIR WITH YOUR DOG

1. Take the Obedience project book
2. Attend and complete Project judging on July 18th at the Summit County Fairgrounds.
3. Complete 3 out of the 5 in-county clinics. The Summit County Jr. Fair Dog program is offering 5 free clinics. One in April, One in May, Two in June and One in July. (please note the July clinic is mandatory)
4. Turn in the completed form "2020 Permission to Participate in Ohio 4-H Dog Activities Disclosure and Release of Claims upon project registration to the 4-H Extension Office with project registration by March 15, 2020.
5. Turn in the completed form "Dog Project Identification and Vaccination Certificate to the 4-H Extension Office. All Dogs must hold a current vaccinations through August 8, 2020, before participating in dog related project activities.

After completing all qualifications, you must register for the Ohio State Fair dog show online by midnight June 20, 2020. No late entries accepted.
