



RULES 4-H DEPARTMENT J13 - J18

Welcome to our new Jr. Fairboard 4-H Department!

This is very new to all of us so please feel free to ask questions and be patient with us as we organize and put this all together.

These departments will partially mirror our Open Class Department in the way we will check in and display the items.

Each Department has sections with different categories.

- 1) **4-Hers, Jr. Fairboard or FFA members must complete an entry form. Fill out the form with what projects you will enter. Entry forms are due in the fair office by May 7th, at 4pm.** You can mail them to PO Box 89, Tallmadge OH 44278 or email to summitfairkq@gmail.com (you can enter as many as you like but only one project per project book but you do not have to bring them all - you can not add anything after May 7)
- 2) **Awards** - Premiums will be awarded for 1st , 2nd, 3rd place in each class. "Fairbucks" will be given as premiums in the amounts of \$3, \$2, and \$1. Fairbucks can be used at select vendors throughout the fair. One outstanding project will be chosen from each department and given best of show. The Best of Show winner will receive a one-day ride pass to be used during the fair.
- 3) Entries should be brought to the Domestic Arts Building, Sunday, July 21st from 1:00 P.M. - 6:00 P.M. - The entry you bring depending on your project will either be a poster board or an item that you made or grew for your project - examples - woodworking, sewing, vegetables, flowers, photography, would be an item. Exploring the outdoors or Science Fun with Physics would be a poster board or some type of display
- 4) Only one entry per project book per exhibitor allowed. Exhibitor can enter as many project books entries as they would like in each department.
- 5) At Check in - Entries must be labeled with name of entrant and name of project book. Project book must be completed for each project and brought to check in.

- 6) For the Cooking and Baking projects, on showing day you will be required to bring a table setting and a cooked or baked item. You will be judged on appearance and on certain items on the taste of food.
- 7) Each department has a judging day. On that day, you will check in and you will retrieve your item and wait to be judged. This judging will be different than grade and exhibit. You will be competing with others that have taken that project as well. Then awards will be given out after judging. Then your item will be returned to the domestic arts for the remainder of fair.
- 8) Items can be picked up Sunday, July 28th starting at 8pm, Or you can pick up your items the week after fair but you must make arrangements with the Jr. Fair Secretary.
- 10) This judging DOES NOT qualify you for State Fair.
