General Rules:

- 1) You may just come for day of showing as a show and go or you may stay the week of fair. Your animal will be housed in the Domestic Arts Building.
- 2) Entry Form must be filed out and returned by May 7th to the Summit County Fair Office - PO Box 89 Tallmadge OH 44278.
- 3) Each animal must be in a secure enclosure with a locking lid and a sign warning patrons DO NOT TOUCH and has a solid bottom.
- 2) Each animal must be owned by the exhibitor and can not be loaned.
- 3) **The exhibitor is responsible for the pet's daily care.**
- 4) Each enclosure must be accompanied by a poster to educate the public about the animal
- 5) Ferrets must have a rabies vaccination certificate and canine distemper
- 6) Judging will be based on animals cage, knowledge of animal and care of animal.
- 7) Judging day will be announced after May 7th due date.
- 8) Awards - 1st - 4th place will be awarded and a Best Overall Pocket Pet Rosette
- 9) If exhibitor needs to remove animal for any reason they must inform 4-H Pocket Pet Coordinator and receive a release form.
- 10) Building is not always maned - a fencing will be put up infront of animals displayed but the fairgrounds, 4-H, Jr. Fairboard or its staff is not responsible for any animals. Exhibitors are welcome to man area during the day at night the building is locked and reopened at 11am.
