4. Have been an active member of a Summit County 4-H club for a minimum of three years
(including the current year)

Applicants will be judged on the following point system:

1. Application and 4-H Fair Story = 50 possible points
2. Interview = 50 possible points

Awards:

One year Scholastic Scholarships (non renewable) in the amount of \$1,000.00

Winning Recipients will be announced during the 4-H Bake Auction. Winner will receive a check payable to the recipient once proof of school enrollment/registration is provided to the fair office. Enrollment must take place during the current year.
