

DEPARTMENT 44 - GOAT DISPLAY

GENERAL RULES:

- 1) All animals will be checked by veterinarian. Must follow state health requirements. Out of state animals must show current CVI issued within 30 days of fair load in.
- 2) No horned animals or bucks permitted on the grounds.
- 3) No bedding will be furnished.
- 4) Each Exhibitor will be allowed to display up to five goats for a total of 30 Display goats. Limited to 6 exhibitors.
- 5) All goats must fit into a section below and must follow all General Rules and ODA Livestock Health and Animal Rules.
- 6) Each exhibitor will receive a premium check of \$50 per goat displayed for the week of fair. If an animal is removed earlier the exhibitor will not be paid.
- 7) Each exhibitor is required to enter and pay the \$25 exhibitor ticket fee.
- 8) There will be no judging, show or awards for animals.
- 9) Superintendent has the right to send unhealthy animals home.
- 10) All goats must be identified with an individual tattoo and herd tattoo or scrapie tag.
- 11) Copy of registration papers must accompany each goat and match the goat's identification number. If microchips are used, exhibitor must provide a reader.
- 12) There will be a banner and \$100 prize money offered per open class barn to the open class exhibitor who decorates their area, stalls or pens following our fair theme. Judges will be through barns Tuesday and banner will be displayed Wednesday - Sunday.
